

CHURCH MATCHING SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

About the Church Matching Scholarship

The Bethel Church Matching Scholarship is a program to assist students and families in financing their Bethel education. Bethel will match a church scholarship up to \$1,000 per year. This match is available for students from any denomination.

New students should complete their application for admission by one of the early application dates (see the application for admission) but no later than May 1. The church match application must be submitted by June 1.

The Church Matching Scholarship is excluded from the Bethel two-award policy. Students who are eligible to receive more than two institutional grants or scholarships will only receive the two largest dollar awards. This applies to all institutional scholarships, with the exception of the Family Grant and Church Matching Scholarship.

HOW IT WORKS

Bethel College will match scholarships that are awarded to an undergraduate student from his or her church. Students living in college housing may receive a match of up to \$1,000 per year. All other students may receive a match of up to \$250 per year. Students may submit scholarships from more than one church and the total of the awards will be used to determine the Bethel College match (up to the limits noted above).

QUALIFICATIONS

- New students should have their application for admission completed by May 1 to be assured consideration.
- Student must enroll as a full-time undergraduate.
- Student must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0.
- Student and church must submit this application to the office of student financial services prior to June 1. Applications received after this deadline will not be matched.

- Scholarship checks must be made out to Bethel College and received in the office of student financial services by September 1 for the fall semester and by January 10 for the spring semester. Scholarship checks must be written from the church, not by individuals.
- A Church Matching Scholarship application must be submitted each year by June 1 to receive the Bethel church match award.
